



Call for 2011-2012 Committee Service

Education Committee

Charge: The Education Committee shall be responsible for the medical and socioeconomic education of the ASHNR members and other professionals who participate in the educational activities of the Society. At the direction of the Executive Committee, the Education Committee shall plan and propose projects to further the educational mission of the Society. In addition, the Education Committee shall select the Outstanding Head and Neck Paper and/or Poster Presentation at the ASNR 50th Annual Meeting and determine which are suitable for presentation at the ASHNR 46th Annual Meeting.

Term: The term of office for the Chairperson of the Education Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. The Chairperson may be reappointed for a total of four more consecutive terms (maximum of five years).

The term of each member of the Education Committee (other than the Chairperson) shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Members may be reappointed for a total of three consecutive one-year terms. At least one member, however, must be replaced each year.

Gold Medal Award Committee

Charge: The Gold Medal Award Committee shall propose a recipient(s) for the 2012 Gold Medal to the Executive Committee at least 60 days prior to the 46th Annual Meeting.

Term: The term of office for each member of the Gold Medal Award Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Members (other than the Chairman) may be reappointed for a total of three consecutive one-year terms. However, at least one member, in addition to the Chairman, must be replaced each year.

Membership Committee

Charge: The Membership Committee shall investigate strategies to increase/retain Society membership, and shall review and approve all applications for membership from applicants who are not members of the ASNR or of any ASNR managed specialty/regional society. In addition, the Membership Committee shall be responsible for contacting members who have not renewed to encourage them to do so.

Term: The term of office of each member of the Membership Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and shall continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Each member (other than the Chairman) may be re-appointed to serve a total of two terms on the Committee.

Nominating Committee

Charge: The Nominating Committee shall propose a slate of officers for the 2012-2013 Executive Committee to the current Executive Committee in accordance with the Society Bylaws and at least 60 days prior to the 46th Annual Meeting. The proposed slate of officers shall then be sent to the membership 30 days prior to the 46th Annual Meeting for election at the October 2012 Annual Business Meeting.

Term: The term of office of each member of the Nominating Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and shall continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Each member (other than the Chairman) may be appointed to serve a total of three terms on the Committee.

Publications Committee

Charge: The Publications Committee shall be responsible for all issues relating to the official Society Journal-the *American Journal of Neuroradiology (AJNR)*. The Publications Committee shall conduct a search and recommend to the Executive Committee an Editor of the Head and Neck section of the *AJNR* when a vacancy exists. The Chairman of the committee shall act as the liaison between the Publications Committee and the Executive Committee.

Term: The term of office for the Chairman of the Publications Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and shall continue for five years until the close of the Annual Meeting. The Chairman may be reappointed for a total of two consecutive terms (maximum of ten years).

The term of office for the members of the Publications Committee (other than the Chairman, the ASHNR Editor of the Journal, and the Chairman of the ASNR Publications Committee) shall be one year in duration beginning at the close of the Annual Meeting at which they were appointed and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Members of the Committee may be reappointed for a total of three consecutive one-year terms. Only two of these three members, however, may be reappointed from one year to the next.

Research Committee

Charge: The Research Committee shall oversee, foster, and continue to develop the research mission of the Society in areas including, but not limited to, developing imaging techniques, economics and cost analysis, outcomes research, best practices and imaging safety, and imaging evaluation of pathologic states.

Term: The term of office of each member of the Research Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and shall continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting.

Rules Committee

Charge: The Rules Committee shall review the Bylaws of the Society, advise the President of proposed changes in the Bylaws, and accept assignments regarding the rules of the Society from President.

Term: The term of office of the Chairman of the Rules Committee shall be for a duration of one year, shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was elected, and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. The term of office for members of the Rules Committee (other than the Chairman) shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which they were appointed and continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting. Each member (other than the Chairman) may be re-appointed to serve a total of two consecutive terms on the Committee.

Ad Hoc Core Curriculum Fund/Corporate Relations Committee

Charge: The Ad Hoc Core Curriculum Fund/Corporate Relations Committee shall solicit funding from corporate as well as individual sponsors to help support the ASHNR Core Curriculum Fund which supports the Society's educational, research, and best clinical practice missions.

Term: The term of office of each member of the Ad Hoc CCF/Corporate Relations Committee shall begin at the close of the Annual Meeting at which he/she was appointed and shall continue until the close of the next Annual Meeting.
